(*isis3mgr/installer/izpack/src/lib/com/izforge/izpack/panels/IsisHelloPanel.java*)

- On prog21 with GNOME, on the panel where you can select which packs to install, checking and un-checking the Isis package does not update its size description.
(*isis3mgr/installer/izpack/src/lib/com/izforge/izpack/panels/TreePacksPanel.java*)
